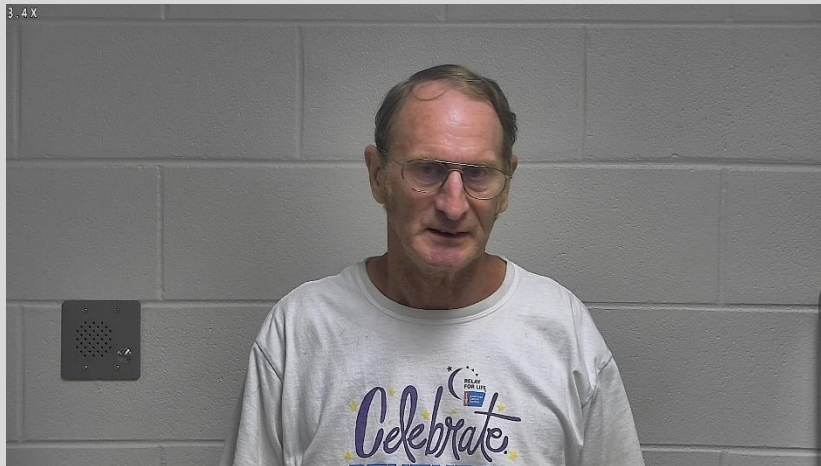

## PRESS RELEASE

### Shooting in Pewee Valley

On Thursday September 6, 2018 at approximately 9:57 PM, The Oldham County Police Department responded to the 100 block of Maple Avenue in Pewee Valley. Upon arrival, police located the victim, June Dean, walking towards the road bleeding from the shoulder. The victim advised that her brother, Lawrence E. Dean, shot her with a rifle. The suspect lives at the address where the shooting occurred. Police were unable to locate Mr. Dean that evening and an arrest warrant was issued. On Friday September 7, 2018, Mr. Dean came to the Oldham County Police Department, where he gave a statement to the police confirming his involvement in the shooting and was subsequently arrested and booked into the Oldham County Jail on charges of Assault 1<sup>st</sup>, and Murder (attempted) - Domestic Violence.
