## Murder (Attempted)

\*\*Update to media release for the 10/2/2022 shooting incident in Crestwood\*\*

Oldham County Police Detectives identified and arrested 29-year-old David Strausburg of Louisville, KY and 28-year-old Ella Whorton of La Grange, KY for the October 2, 2022, shooting on Crestview Drive. Strausburg was charged with one count each of Murder (Attempted), Assault 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, & Wanton Endangerment 1<sup>st</sup> Degree. Whorton was charged with one count each of Murder (Attempted/Facilitation), Assault 1<sup>st</sup> Degree, Assault 4<sup>th</sup> Degree, Menacing, Terroristic Threatening 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree & Disorderly Conduct 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. Both Strausburg and Whorton were lodged in the Oldham County Jail pending arraignment.

Detectives coordinated with other law enforcement agencies and located Strausburg and Whorton in the Mt. Washington area of Bullitt County.
