Fatal Traffic Collision

On July 23, 2022, at approximately 2:40 PM, the Oldham County Police Department received reports of a multi-vehicle collision on northbound I-71 near the rest area.

Officers arriving on scene determined that a grey 2016 Subaru and two tractor trailers were involved, with one of the tractor trailers on fire.

The driver of the Subaru, 19 year old Sean T. Ingalls of West Chester, OH was pronounced deceased at the scene. No other occupants were in the Subaru.

Drivers of the tractor trailers; Abdirizak Mohamud of Columbus, OH, and Darquin Turner of Webster, TX, were not injured during the collision. No passengers were present in either commercial vehicle.

I-71 northbound was closed for approximately five and a half hours to allow emergency services to conduct their investigation, perform fire-rescue operations, and coordinate the removal of involved vehicles. The interstate was reopened to traffic at 8:32 PM.

The exact cause of the collision is still under investigation, however no criminal charges are anticipated. No additional information is available at this time.
