Robbery 1st Degree

Update to the original media release

Oldham County Police Detectives have identified 25-year-old Issac C. Beck of Smithville, TN as the person believed responsible for the 9/2/2022 robbery of Prospect Liquors in Oldham County. Detectives coordinated with other law enforcement agencies and determined that at the time of the Prospect robbery Beck was driving a silver Toyota Camry (originally described by witnesses as a Nissan) stolen from Casey County, KY. Beck was arrested the afternoon of September 2nd by the Salem (IN) Police Department on charges unrelated to our investigation and is currently lodged in the Washington County (IN) Detention Center. An Oldham District Court arrest warrant for Robbery 1st Degree and Wanton Endangerment 1st Degree has been issued and officials will coordinate with Indiana for extradition back to Kentucky.

The Oldham County Police would like to thank the Kentucky State Police, Salem (IN) Police Department, and Washington County (IN) Sheriff's Office for their assistance in this investigation.

Information from previous media release dated 9/2/2022

On September 2, 2022, at approximately 09:40 A.M. Oldham County Police responded to Prospect Liquors, located in the 13000 block of W. Hwy 42 in Prospect, for a reported robbery that had just occurred. The initial investigation indicates an unknown white male, wearing a mask over his face and armed with a handgun, entered the business, and demanded money from the employee. After taking an unknown amount of money, the suspect fled the scene in a silver Nissan sedan towards Jefferson County. No injuries were reported to any employees of the business at the time of the robbery. This incident is still under investigation, and we will provide further updates if new information becomes available.
